## 1) Apparent (Adjective) – प्रत्यक्ष या स्पष्ट

**Meaning:** clearly visible or understood; obvious.

**Synonyms:** evident, plain, obvious

**Antonyms:** unclear, obscure

**Usage:** “for no apparent reason she laughed”

## 2) Consign (Verb) – भेजना, पहुँचाना, सौंपना

**Meaning:** put someone or something in (a place) in order to be rid of it or them.

**Synonyms:** send, deliver, hand over

**Antonyms:** keep, hold, detain

**Usage:** “she consigned the letter to the waste-paper basket”

## 3) Delinquent (Adjective) – अपराधी या दोषी

**Meaning:** tending to commit crime, particularly minor crime.

**Synonyms:** lawless, lawbreaking, criminal

**Antonyms:** well behaved, conformist

**Usage:** “delinquent teenagers”

## 4) Obviate (Verb) – हटाना या रोकना

**Meaning:** remove (a need or difficulty).

**Synonyms:** preclude, prevent, remove

**Antonyms:** aid, allow, assist

**Usage:** “the presence of roller blinds obviated the need for curtains”

## 5) Precedent (Noun) – मिसाल

**Meaning:** an earlier event or action that is regarded as an example or guide to be considered in subsequent similar circumstances.

**Synonyms:** model, exemplar, example

**Antonyms:** after, ensuing, following

**Usage:** “there are substantial precedents for using interactive media in training”

## 6) Fright (Noun) – डर या भय

**Meaning:** a sudden intense feeling of fear.

**Synonyms:** fear, fearfulness, terror

**Antonyms:** boldness, bravery, courage

**Usage:** “I jumped up in fright”

## 7) Imperative (Adjective) – महत्वपूर्ण

**Meaning:** of vital importance; crucial.

**Synonyms:** vital, crucial, critical

**Antonyms:** unimportant, optional

**Usage:** “immediate action was imperative”

## 8) Unanimous (Adjective) – सर्व-सम्मत

**Meaning:** fully in agreement.

**Synonyms:** united, in complete agreement

**Antonyms:** divided, at odds

**Usage:** “the doctors were unanimous in their diagnoses”

## 9) Conservative (Adjective) – रूढ़िवादी

**Meaning:** averse to change or innovation and holding traditional values.

**Synonyms:** traditionalist, traditional, conventional

**Antonyms:** radical

**Usage:** "they were very conservative in their outlook"

**10) Surveillance (Noun)** – निगरानी

**Meaning:** close observation, especially of a suspected spy or criminal.

**Synonyms:** observation, scrutiny, watch

**Antonyms:** carelessness, ignorance, indifference

**Usage:** "he found himself put under surveillance by British military intelligence"
