likely to happen.

Synonyms: presage, augur, foreshadow

Usage: "the eclipses portend some major events"

## 2) Ominous (Adjective) - अमंगल

Meaning: giving the worrying impression that something bad is going to happen; threateningly

inauspicious.

**Synonyms**: threatening, menacing, baleful **Antonyms**: promising, auspicious, propitious

Usage: "there were ominous dark clouds gathering overhead"

#### 3) Protracted (Adjective) - दीर्घकालिक

Meaning: lasting for a long time or longer than expected or usual.

Synonyms: prolonged, extended, stretched out

Antonyms: brief, short, fleeting

Usage: "a protracted and bitter dispute"

### 4) Exempt (Adjective) - दायित्व से मुक्त

**Meaning**: free from an obligation or liability imposed on others.

Synonyms: free from, not liable to, not subject to

**Antonyms**: liable to, subject to

**Usage:** "these patients are exempt from all charges"

#### 5) Slump (Verb) - भारी और सीमित रूप से गिरना

**Meaning**: sit, lean, or fall heavily and limply.

**Synonyms**: flop, flump, collapse **Antonyms**: stand up, sit up

**Usage:** "she slumped against the cushions"

# 6) Cascading (Verb) - तेजी से नीचे की ओर डालना

**Meaning**: pour downwards rapidly and in large quantities.

**Synonyms:** pour, gush, surge **Antonyms:** stop, cease, contain

Usage: "water was cascading down the stairs"

# 7) Tumbling (Verb) - अचानक सिर के बल गिरना

# 8) Reeling (Adjective) - डगमगाना या लड़खड़ाना

Meaning: lose one's balance and stagger or lurch violently.

Synonyms: stumble, totter, wobble

Antonyms: sober, straight

Usage: "he punched Connolly in the ear, sending him reeling"

# 9)Imperative (Adjective) - आज्ञार्थक या शीर्ष प्राथमिकता

**Meaning:** of vital importance; crucial. **Synonyms:** vital, crucial, critical **Antonyms:** unimportant, optional

Usage: "immediate action was imperative"

## 10) Distressed (Verb) - व्यथित होना

Meaning: cause (someone) anxiety, sorrow, or pain.

**Synonyms**: grieve, sadden, trouble **Antonyms**: calm, soothe, please **Usage**: "I didn't mean to distress you"
