### 1) Mooted (Verb) – उठाना

**Meaning:** raise (a question or topic) for discussion; suggest (an idea or possibility).

**Synonyms:** raise, bring up, broach

**Antonyms:** accomplished, certain

**Usage:** “the scheme was first mooted last October”

### 2) Revival (Noun) – पुनः प्रवर्तन

**Meaning:** an improvement in the condition, strength, or fortunes of someone or something.

**Synonyms:** improvement, rallying, picking up

**Antonyms:** downturn

**Usage:** “a revival in the fortunes of the party”

### 3) Perverse (Adjective) – विकृत, अजीब

**Meaning:** showing a deliberate and obstinate desire to behave in a way that is unreasonable or unacceptable.

**Synonyms:** awkward, contrary, difficult

**Antonyms:** accommodating, cooperative

**Usage:** “Kate’s perverse decision not to cooperate held good”

### 4) Embarked (Verb) – पोतारोहण करना

**Meaning:** go on board a ship or aircraft.

**Synonyms:** take ship, take off, hop on

**Antonyms:** disembark, land

**Usage:** “he embarked for India in 1817”

### 5) Assent (Verb) – सहमति प्रकट करना

**Meaning:** express approval or agreement.

**Synonyms:** agree to, accept, approve

**Antonyms:** dissent from, refuse

**Usage:** “the Prime Minister assented to the change”

### 6) Egregious (Adjective) – बहुत बुरा या चौंका देने वाला

**Meaning:** outstandingly bad; shocking.

**Synonyms:** shocking, appalling, horrific

**Antonyms:** marvelous

**Usage:** “egregious abuses of copyright”

### 7) Apathy (Noun) – रुचि या उत्साह की कमी

**Meaning:** lack of interest, enthusiasm, or concern.

**Synonyms:** indifference, lack of interest, lack of enthusiasm

**Antonyms:** enthusiasm, interest, passion

**Usage:** “widespread apathy among students”

### 8) Mutilation (Noun) – अंगभंग

**Meaning:** the action of mutilating or being mutilated.

**Synonyms:** maiming, disfigurement, dismembering

**Antonyms:** reparation, improvement, rebuilding

**Usage:** “a culture which found any mutilation of the body abhorrent”

### 9) Scrap (Verb) – सेवा से हटाना

**Meaning:** discard or remove from service

**Synonyms:** throw away, throw out, dispose of

**Antonyms:** keep, preserve

**Usage:** "a bold decision was taken to scrap existing plant"

**10) Entail (Verb)** – आवश्यक होना

**Meaning:** involve (something) as a necessary or inevitable part or consequence.

**Synonyms:** necessitate, make necessary, require

**Antonyms:** exclude, omit, untangle

**Usage:** "a situation which entails considerable risks"
