6) Slumber (Verb) – ਜੀਂਵ

Meaning: sleep.

Synonyms: sleep, be asleep, doze

Antonyms: wake up

Usage: "Sleeping Beauty slumbered in her forest castle"

7) Onerous (Adjective) - कष्टदायक

Meaning: involving a great deal of effort, trouble, or difficulty.

Synonyms: burdensome, heavy, inconvenient

Antonyms: easy, effortless

Usage: "he found his duties increasingly onerous"

8) Desperate (Adjective) - बेकरार

Meaning: feeling or showing a hopeless sense that a situation is so bad as to be impossible to deal

with.

Synonyms: despairing, hopeless, anguished

Antonyms: cheerful, composed

Usage: "a desperate sadness enveloped Ruth"

9)Mitigate (Verb) - संकोच

Meaning: make (something bad) less severe, serious, or painful.

Synonyms:alleviate, reduce, diminish
