especially ones that are equally undesirable. **Synonyms**: quandary, predicament, difficulty **Antonyms**: solutions, resolutions, answers

Usage: "he wants to make money, but he also disapproves of it: Den's dilemma in a nutshell"

5) Peculiar (Adjective) - अजीब, असामान्य, अनोखा

Meaning: different to what is normal or expected; strange.

Synonyms: strange, unusual, odd **Antonyms**: normal, ordinary

Usage: "he gave her some very peculiar looks"

6) Convalescent (Adjective) - स्वस्थ होना

Meaning: recovering from an illness or medical treatment.

Synonyms: recuperating, recovering **Antonyms**: deteriorating, failing **Usage**: "a convalescent child"

7) Feasibility (Noun) - व्यवहार्यता

Meaning: the state or degree of being easily or conveniently done.

Synonyms: practicability, practicality

Antonyms: impracticability

Usage: "the feasibility of screening athletes for cardiac disease"

8) Efficacy (Noun) - प्रभावोत्पादकता

Meaning: the ability to produce a desired or intended result.

Synonyms: effectiveness, success

Antonyms: inefficacy

Usage: "there is little information on the efficacy of this treatment"

9) Ascertain (Verb) - पता लगाना

Meaning: find (something) out for certain; make sure of.

Synonyms: discover, get/come to know
